Canoeing & Day at Toronto Island

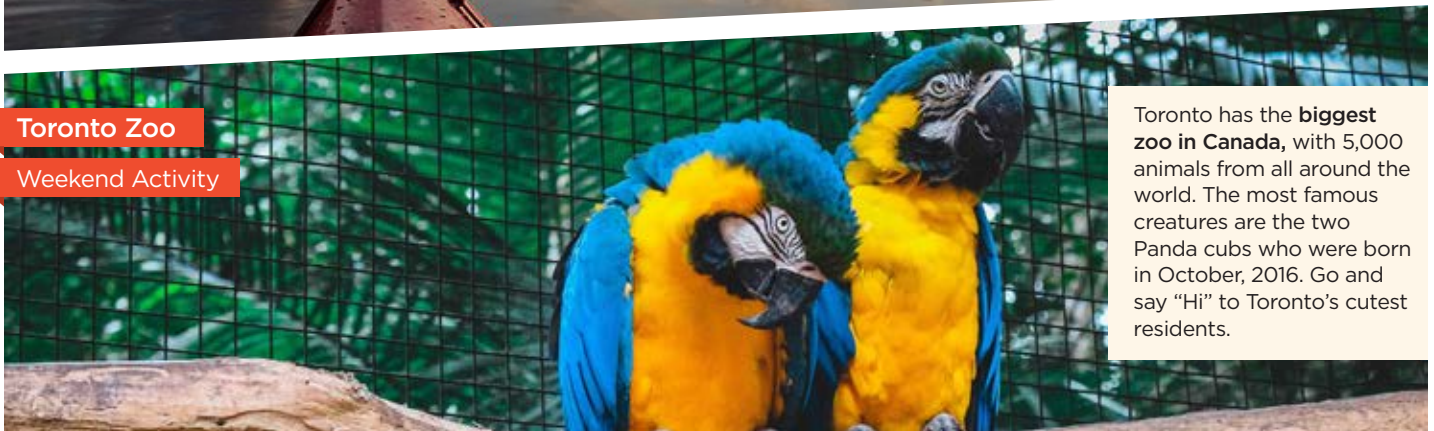
Weekend Activity

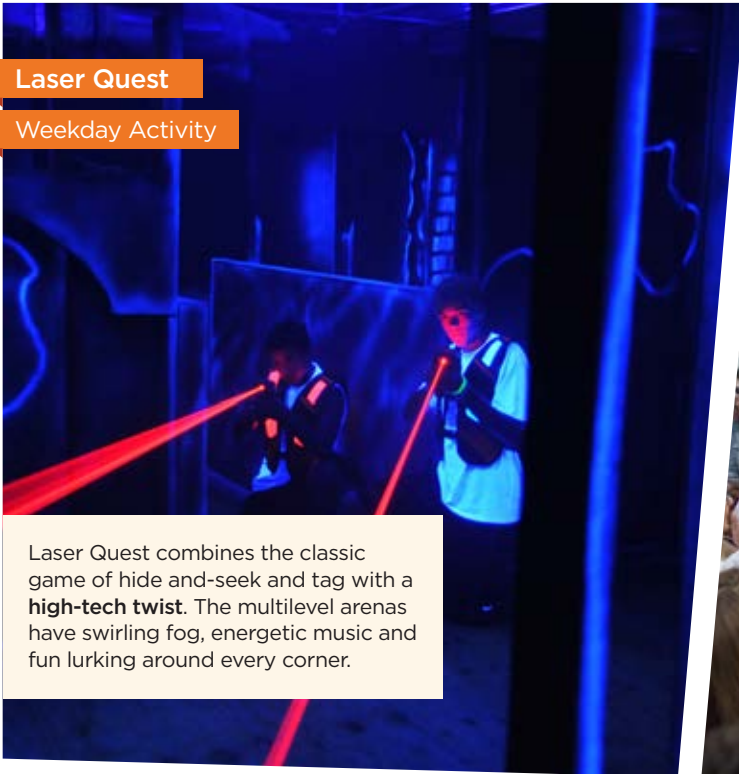

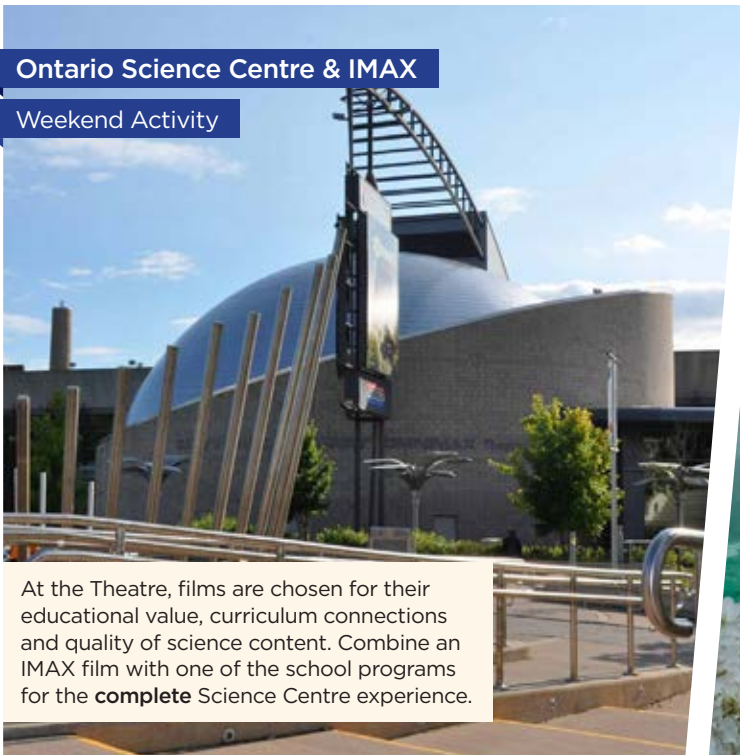

Ontario Science Centre & IMAX

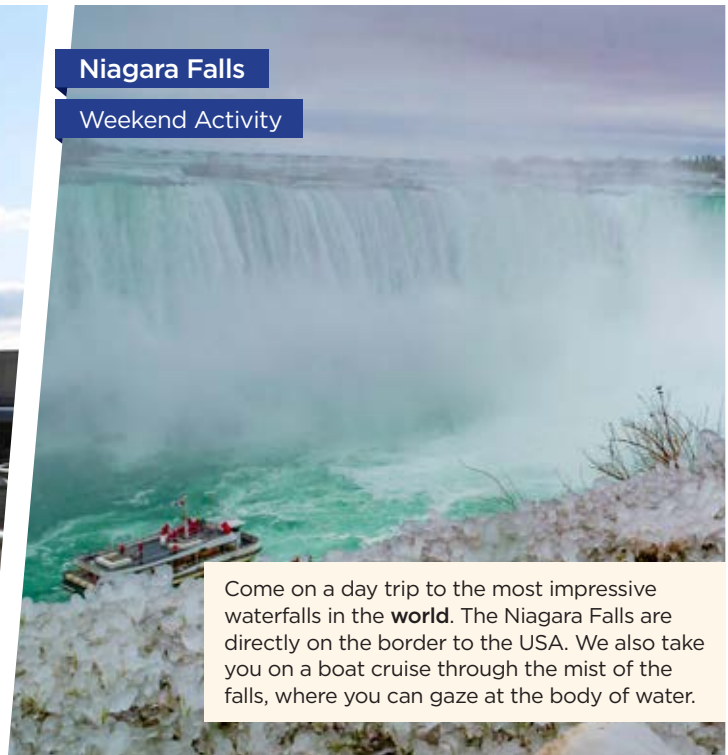
Weekend Activity

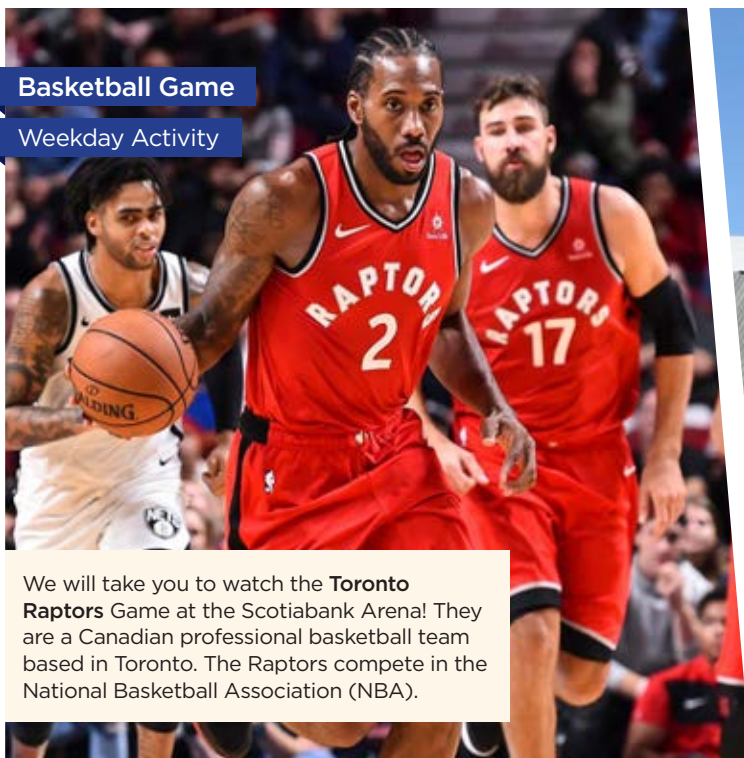

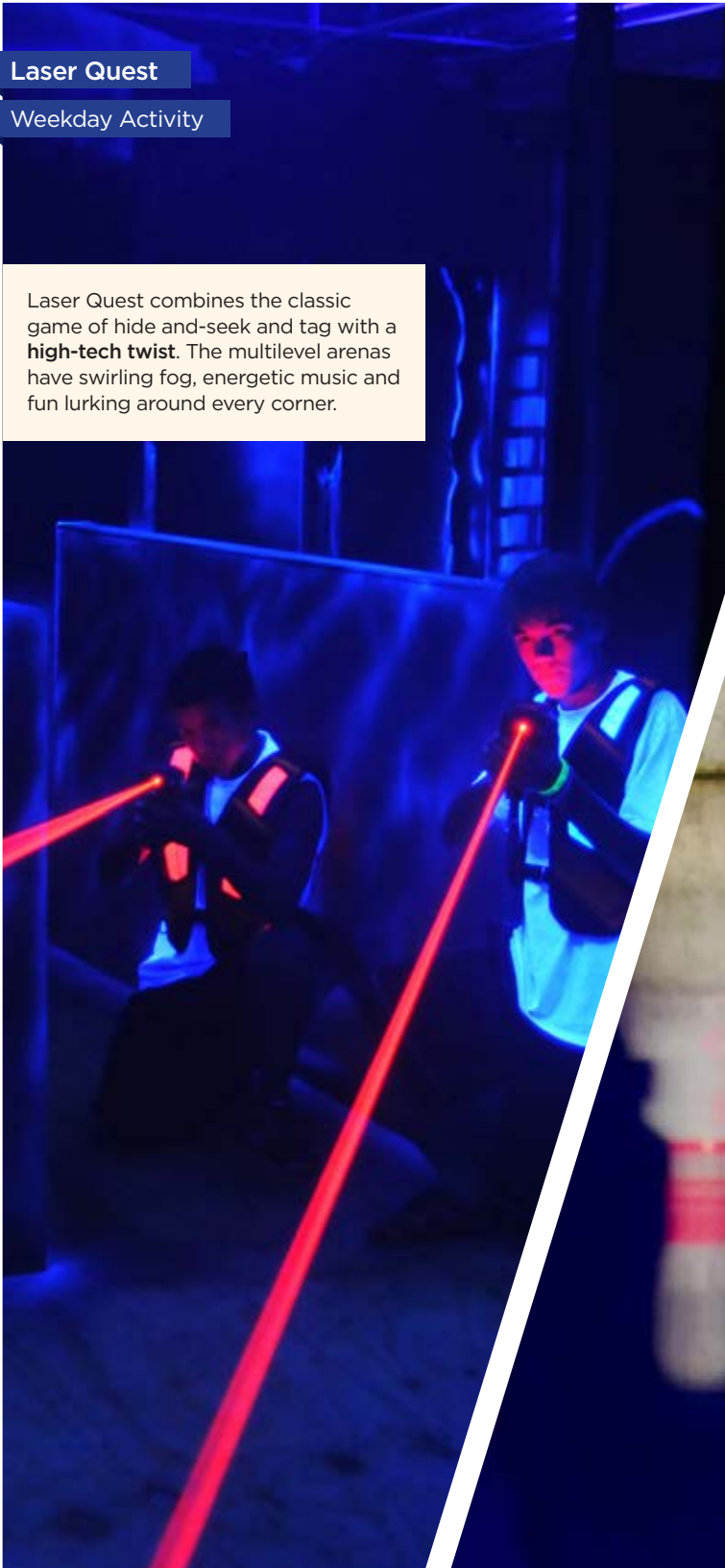

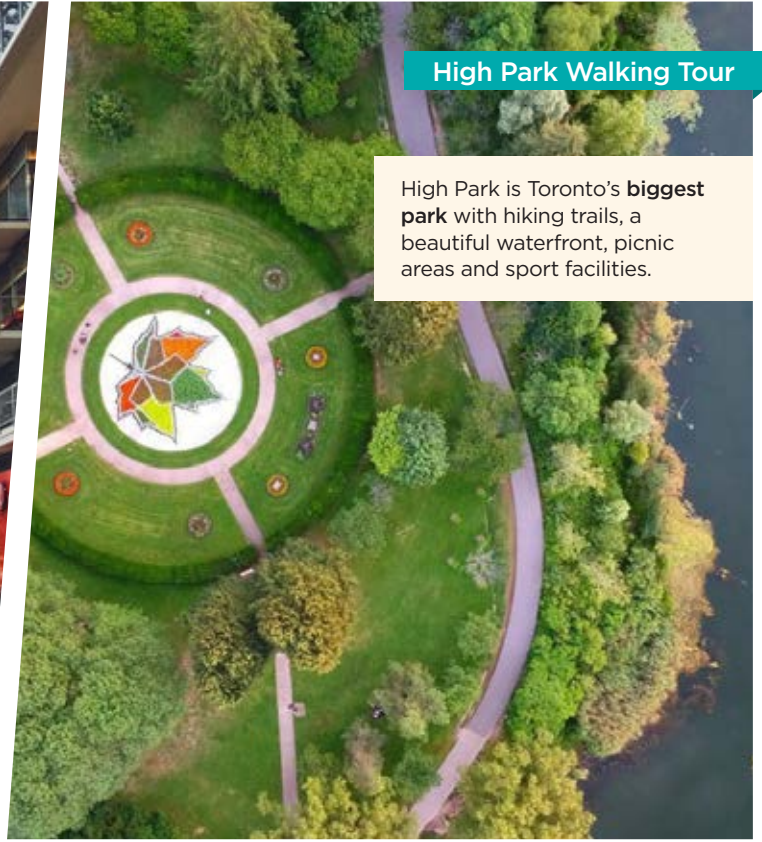
Eaton Centre

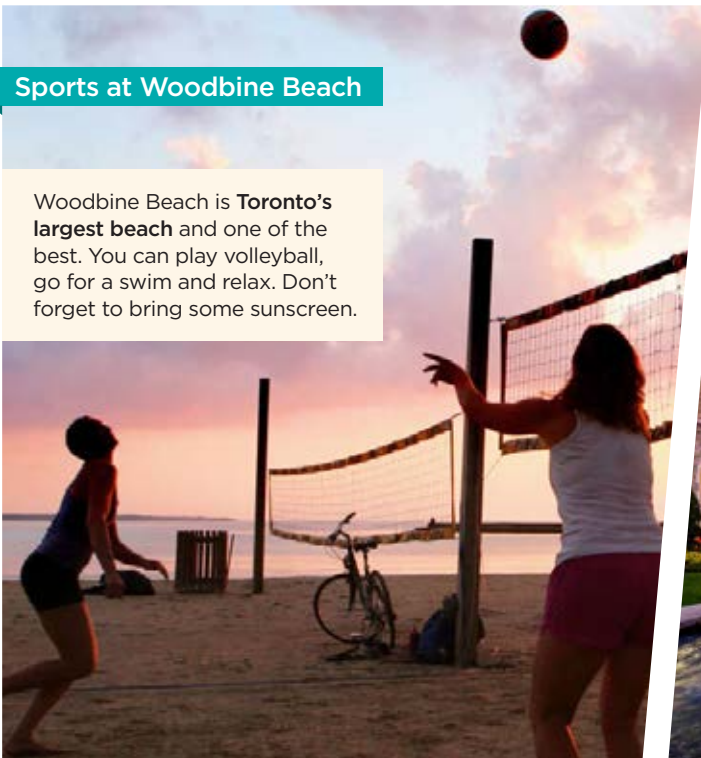
High Park Walking Tour

High Park is Toronto's **biggest park** with hiking trails, a beautiful waterfront, picnic areas and sport facilities.



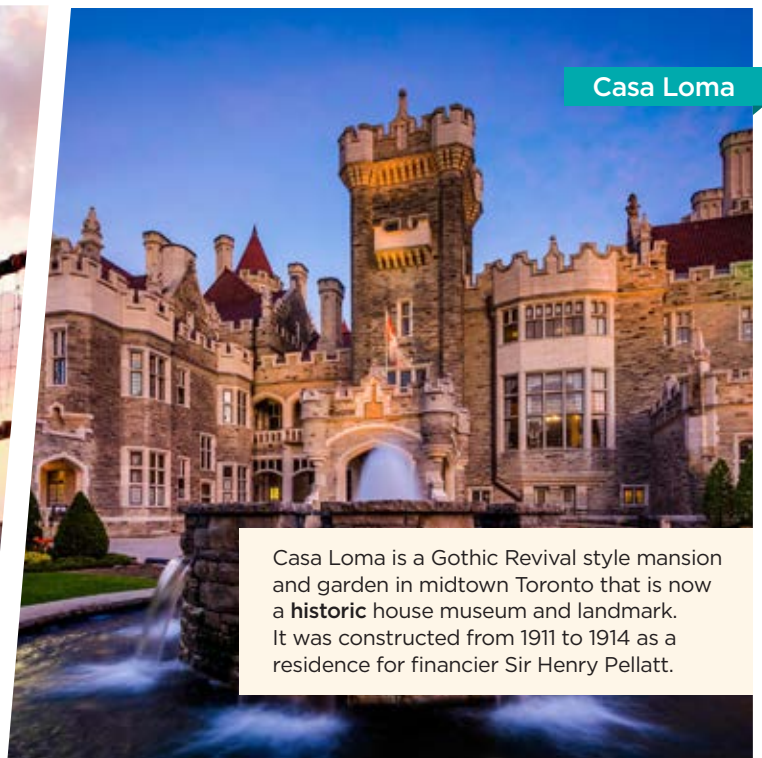
Sports at Woodbine Beach

China Town & Kensington Market Walking Tour

Queen Street

Distillery District

The Distillery District is a commercial and residential district in Toronto. Art lovers come for the galleries, outdoor sculptures and dance, music and stage performances at the area's several theatres. In December, the annual Toronto **Christmas Market** takes over the streets.



Scarborough Bluffs Park

There are nine parks along the bluffs, with Bluffers Park being the only one with a beach. Forming much of the eastern portion of Toronto waterfront, the Scarborough Bluffs stands above the shoreline of Lake Ontario. **Lovely view** and a good variety of things to do for people.
